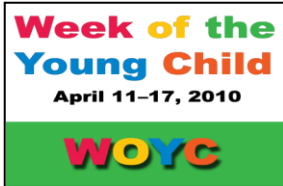


## Amazing, Awesome, and Astounding April 2010 at the Sayre Public Library
